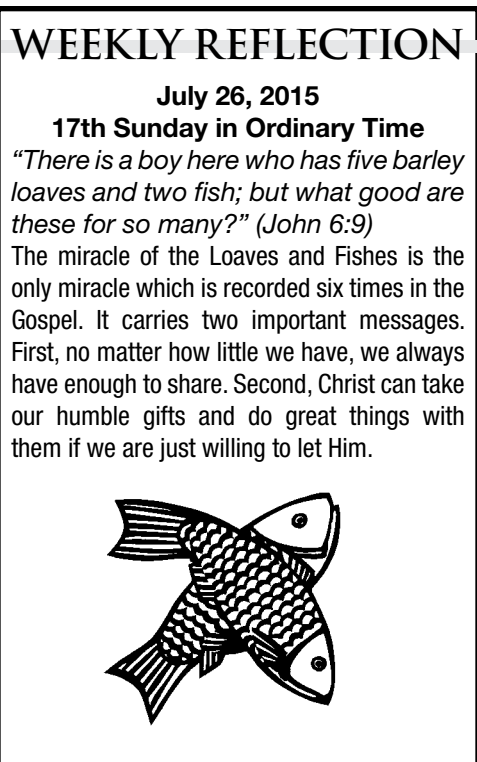
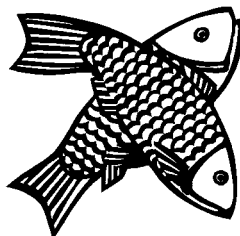
WEEKLY REFLECTION

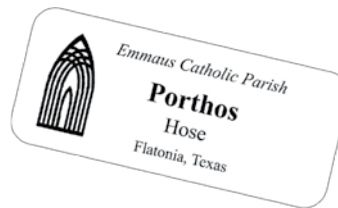
