The Bishop has asked **FR. HARRY** to take a new assignment at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Killeen beginning Feb. 1. Fr. Harry will celebrate his final Masses at Emmaus the weekend of **Jan. 30-31** on Saturday at 5 PM and Sunday at 8:30 AM and 10:30 AM. Please stop by to visit with Fr. Harry after Mass. A basket will be available in the narthex if you'd like to leave a card with your well wishes. He will be missed!

DÍA DE LA CANDELARIA (Candlemas), like many other Mexican celebrations, represents a fusion of pre-Hispanic traditions and Catholic beliefs. Celebrated on Feb. 2, this celebration falls forty days after Christmas, and is recognized by Catholics as the "Feast of Purification" or as the "Presentation of Christ at the Temple." According to Jewish law, it was customary to bring a baby to the temple after a period of purification had passed; so Jesus would have been taken to the temple on such an occasion. Another important custom in Mexico is for families to have their own image of the Christ child, a *Niño Dios*. At times a godparent is chosen for the Niño Dios, and is then responsible for hosting various celebrations between Christmas and Candlemas. First, on Christmas Eve, the Niño Dios is placed in the Nativity scene; on Jan. 6, King's Day, the child is brought presents from the Magi; and on Feb. 2, the child is dressed in fine clothes and presented in the church. This ritual will be celebrated at Emmaus immediately following the 12:15 PM Mass on Sunday, **Jan. 31**. Please join us!

As Fr. Samuel shared last weekend at Masses, **FR. EVERARDO CÁZARES** will join Emmaus as Parochial Vicar beginning **Feb. 1**. You can read about Fr. Cazares, who was ordained this past weekend, in the latest edition of the Catholic Spirit (austindiocese.org/offices-ministries/offices/catholic-spirit). Please join us in welcoming him to our parish family.

CHURCH WIDE WEDNESDAY returns **Feb. 3**. Let's come together as a parish family! On this Feast of St. Blaise we will participate in the traditional blessing of throats at the 5:30 PM Mass, and follow it up with a Holy Spirit Potluck in the Great Hall. A CHANGE TO ADORATION

We have been experiencing more and more absences in the Adoration Chapel during the overnight hours. Of course, it's very difficult for people to cover these hours, particularly if they have families and jobs that require their attention during the day. It is very important, however, that if there is not going to be an adorer present, Jesus be reposed.

Therefore, beginning February 1, there will be a change to the Adoration Chapel and scheduling. Jesus will be reposed nightly at 10 PM and exposed the next morning at 5 AM. Adorers who are scheduled regularly during the daily 9-10 PM and 5-6 AM hours will be trained on the process.

The chapel will remain open and Adoration may continue to take place when the Eucharist is not exposed and left in the tabernacle, but constant attendance will not be necessary during those overnight hours of 10 PM to 5 AM. You may pray in Jesus' presence 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - whenever you'd like to stop in.

If you are currently signed up for an overnight time slot and would like to change your commitment to an hour between 5 AM and 10 PM, there are some hourly shifts during the day that need adorers. You can always add your commitment to an hour where there are already people signed up.
