SOCIAL OUTREACH

One hundred thirteen clients came to the **HELPING HAND CRISIS MINISTRY OF SPICEWOOD** during May requesting food assistance for their 221 family members. Six of these clients were first-time visitors. Forty-seven families received financial assistance totaling \$5,723. Fifty-three percent of the financial assistance was to help with housing costs, twenty-two percent for transportation and communication expenses with the remaining twenty-five percent for dental and medical expenses. A special \$3,500 donation was made to a community-wide fundraiser to help a neighbor who was involved in a tragic automobile accident. His mother and wife were killed and he suffered injuries that will prevent him from operating his business for the foreseeable future. The cost for food and personal hygiene products totaled \$1,476. Ministry operating expenses totaled \$926. Expenditures totaled \$11,625 and donations totaled \$9,603. At month's end, the Vista House continues to be occupied by clients who would otherwise be homeless. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.

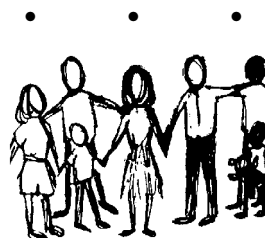
