On August 17th local dental professionals, LTlov & community volunteers came together for our 6th annual Kids Free Dental Day at the Lakeway Dental Office to provide oral health care to 53 local children whose financial circumstances impede basic dental visits. Each patient received a thorough cleaning & dentist's exam including x-rays & sealants as needed.

Services such as fillings & extractions were performed on the spot in most cases so patients went home with a healthy mouth & a sparkling smile. 33 children were return patients, 14 patients require follow-up care.

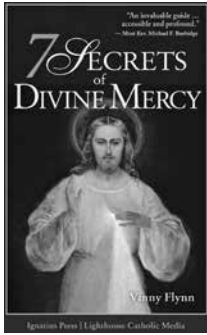
