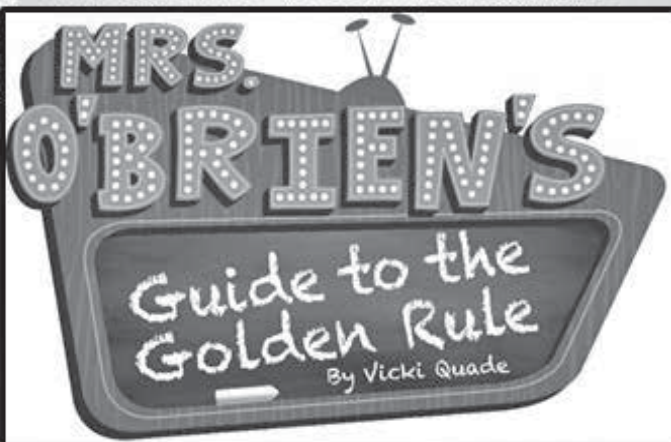

### Personal Biography



Father Rito Davila was born in Nicaragua on May 22, 1972, in the city of Trinidad, State of Estelí. He did his studies of Philosophy and Theology in the Seminary "Our Lady of Fatima" in Managua. He was ordained a priest on July 2, 2005. He belongs to the Diocese of Estelí. After a year of being ordained, he was sent to the Diocese of Austin for five years. He served at Christ the King in Austin, Ascension in Bastrop, and Santa Cruz in Buda.

He has been serving in the Archdiocese of New York for five years at Our Lady of Refuge Parish in the Bronx. Now again he is preparing to begin a new experience at Emmaus Catholic Parish in the Diocese of Austin, which he considers his home. Father Rito says that with trust in God and the prayers of the faithful, he wishes to serve his new community assigned to him by the Bishops of Austin, Joe Vásquez and Daniel Garcia.

### Biografía Personal

## Helping Hand of Spicewood Crisis Ministry

### EMMAUS THANKS YOU

One hundred thirty-nine clients came to the ministry requesting food assistance for their 308 family members. Six of these clients were first-time visitors. Fifty-eight families received financial assistance totaling \$5,325.

Housing assistance totaled \$2,459, transportation and communication assistance totaled \$1,996, and dental / medical assistance totaled \$870. The cost for food and personal hygiene products was \$1,745. Ministry operating expenses were \$514. Expenditures totaled \$7,584 and donations totaled \$7,265.

At month's end, the Vista House was occupied by a single mom with 3 kids who would otherwise be homeless.

### From Your Parish Nursing Ministry | DEALING WITH FAMILY STRESS

Families are experiencing more and more stress these days. Stress in the family is related to different factors. First, the roles of men and women have been changing. Second, many families are caring for both young children and older parents. Third, many live apart from all other family members. Fourth, the busyness of daily life leaves little time or energy to invest in our families. Fifth, financial concerns continue to be a major cause of family conflict. How can families ever hope to cope with all these pressures?

There are several positive things Christian families can do to improve their ability to cope with stressors.

**First:** Place Jesus at the head of your family. Ephesians 4:15 says, "We will in all things grow up into Him who is the Head, that is Christ."

**Second:** pray for the Lord's guidance for your family, and pray for one another. Have a family prayer time and include all members.

**Third:** Trust your family can handle the pressures, with the help of God. Often workable solutions are within your grasp!

**Fourth:** Develop a realistic plan for resolving your problems. Remember to include all members who will be affected by the plan.

**Fifth:** Seek outside help when you need it. Seeking social support and other outside help is a sign of family strength.
