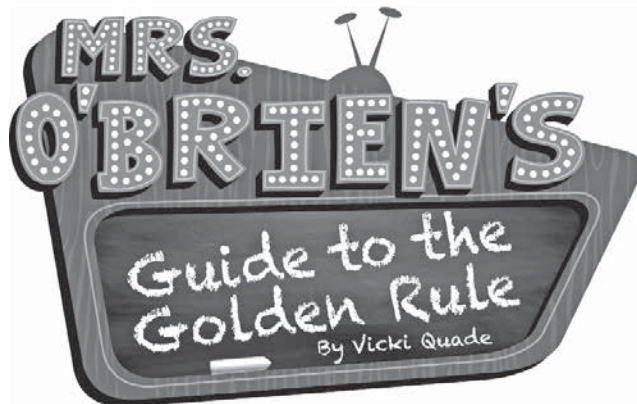

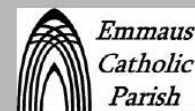

## Capital Campaign Update

#338 of families participating, %13.5 of parish  
\$1,187,345 total pledged, %31.6 of 2020 campaign goal  
\$1,055,025 total cash in hand, %60 of September 30 goal

Please keep these campaign dates in mind:

- September 30 is our goal to have \$1.75 Million in the bank so we can engage a building contractor and architect.
- November 30 is the last day that our campaign donations are not subject to the Diocesan assessment (the cathedraticum). Anything we receive after that date will be divided, 90% to Emmaus and 10% to the Diocese.
- October 31, 2020 is the end of the three year campaign. This is the date on which we hope to have raised the complete \$3.725 Million and have no loans to pay.
