The Silver Rose Program for 2017: Emmaus Catholic Parish is most fortunate that our Knights of Columbus council was able to obtain the Silver Rose for a prayer service on Sunday, August 13, 1:30 PM in the Church. All are invited to attend a 30 minute Prayer Service, conducted by Deacon Terry, and then witness the beauty of this Silver Rose up close.

Beginning in March 2017, six Silver Roses started their journey across North America, from Canada to the United States to Mexico. The 2017 Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose - One Life, One Rose Program will conclude on December 12, 2017 on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas, at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico. 2017 marks the 57th year of the program which began in 1960 to honor the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas. The program has continued since then as a project of Knights of Columbus councils and Fourth Degree assemblies in several jurisdictions.

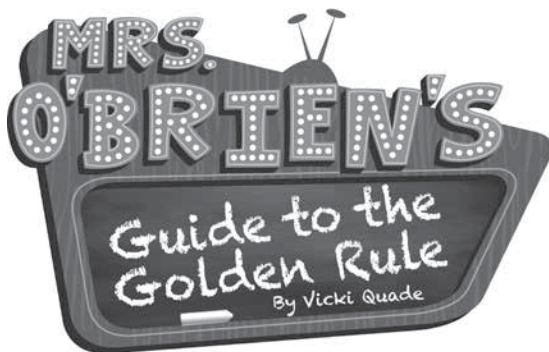
