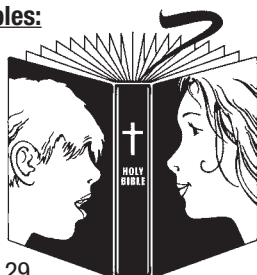

From Fr. Samuel and Your Parish Nursing Ministry

The cold and flu season is here. Do you know the difference between a cold and the flu?

Here are some ways to tell the difference:

Flu vs Cold

Signs and Symptoms	Influenza	Cold
Symptom onset	Abrupt	Gradual
Fever	Usual; lasts 3-4 days	Rare
Aches	Usual; often severe	Slight
Chills	Fairly common	Uncommon
Fatigue, weakness	Usual	Sometimes
Sneezing	Sometimes	Common
Stuffy nose	Sometimes	Common
Sore throat	Sometimes	Common
Chest discomfort, cough	Common; can be severe	Mild to moderate; hacking cough
Headache	Common	Rare

Preventing the Flu: What can you do to prevent getting the flu in addition to getting your flu shot?

- Wash your hands! Use soap, water and friction and wash your hands for as long as it takes you to say The Lord's Prayer. Viruses and bacteria are spread primarily by hand to hand contact.
- Do not touch your face. The only way those germs get to your face is if you put them there.
- Do not stop sneezes and coughs with your hands. Use a tissue and then throw it away or cough into your sleeve.
- Drink plenty of fluids, especially water, to keep hydrated and flush out toxins.
- Get aerobic exercise—it enhances the immune system.
- Do not smoke—it zaps the immune system, dries out the nasal passages and paralyzes the cilia that clean the respiratory system.
- Get plenty of rest! Relax and do things you enjoy.
- If you feel ill with a cough, fever, headache, achy joints, etc. do yourself and your co-workers a favor: STAY HOME!

Remember that for people in good health, the flu will make you ill but it is not life threatening. Take good care of yourself! Submitted by Chantel Reid, RN

From Fr. Samuel:

- You do not have to go to confession if you miss Mass because you are sick.
- If you need to miss Mass in order to take care of sick children that is okay as well.
- If you are well enough to come to Mass but still have even minor symptoms please refrain from receiving from the cup. One receives the fullness of the sacrament of the Eucharist in either the bread or the wine.
- If you are uncomfortable with shaking hands during the flu season it is okay to substitute a warm smile when you say "peace be with you." Do make it a really friendly smile.

Lenten Retreat: Discipleship and the Art of Hanging



"Missionary discipleship" is a term made familiar by Pope Francis' apostolic exhortation *EVANGELII GAUDIUM* (*The Joy of the Gospel*). But what does it mean for the "person in the pew?" This one-day retreat—designed to help you enter more fully into the Lenten season—will look at the practical implications of missionary discipleship against the backdrop of Jesus' crucifixion as described in the Gospels.

Sharon K. Perkins, diocesan Director of the Secretariat for Formation and Spirituality, is former Director of Adult Faith Formation at Emmaus and an adjunct faculty member of the University of Dallas, School of Ministry. She has taught theology and spirituality courses, led retreats in four dioceses, and written numerous articles for the Catholic Press for over thirty years.
