SOCIAL MINISTRY

Winter is the cold and flu season. Viruses are spread from person to person through respiratory droplets when you cough, talk or sneeze. They like to hang out where there are plenty of people. You may be at a higher risk for complications from the flu if you have diabetes, asthma, heart disease or cancer, are pregnant, elderly or are younger than 2 years old. What can you do to stop the spread of cold or flu? Wash your hands often and for as long as it takes to say “The Lord’s Prayer” using soap, water and friction. Stay from people who are sick and stay home if you are sick. Cough or sneeze into a tissue or into the sleeve of your arm. Go to bed and sleep if you are tired. Drink plenty of water or juice.
