## SOCIAL MINISTRY

One hundred nineteen clients came to the **HELPING HAND CRISIS MINISTRY OF SPICEWOOD** during February requesting food assistance for their 348 family members. Eight of these clients were first-time visitors.

Fifty-two families received financial assistance totaling \$10,248. Forty-four percent of the financial assistance was to help with housing costs, nine percent for transportation and communication expenses, with the remaining forty-seven percent for dental and medical expenses. The cost for food and personal hygiene products totaled \$1,633. Ministry operating expenses totaled \$721. Expenditures totaled \$12,602 and donations totaled \$8,159. At month's end, the Vista House continued to be occupied by a family who would otherwise be homeless. The Oak Hill RV continues to be vacant but we hope to resume occupancy sometime in March. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.
