SOICAL OUTREACH

Ninety clients came to the **HELPING HAND CRISIS MINISTRY OF SPICEWOOD** during April requesting food assistance for their 214 family members. Three of these clients were first-time visitors. Sixty-five families received financial assistance totaling \$11,048. Nineteen percent of the financial assistance was to help with housing costs, twenty-three percent for transportation and communication expenses with the remaining fifty-eight percent for dental and medical expenses. The cost for food and personal hygiene products totaled \$1,238. Ministry operating expenses totaled \$472. Expenditures totaled \$12,758 and donations totaled \$8,890. The ministry received a \$16 donation from two children who sold golf balls and lemonade to raise money for the ministry. At month's end, the Vista House continued to be occupied by a client family that would otherwise be homeless. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.
