SOCIAL OUTREACH

GETTING BACK TO SCHOOL: After a long summer break it's time for the kids to head back to school and focus on classes, sports and other school activities. Most children need help transitioning back into a routine for a successful start to the school year.

1. Get back-to-school physicals and make sure vaccinations are current.
 2. Establish a sleep routine. Children and adolescents typically need more than eight hours. To get your children ready to wake up earlier for school, consider making bedtimes a little earlier each night for a week or two before school starts.
 3. Teach a refresher course on good hygiene to protect them from all the germs that are lurking in a full classroom, like washing hands often with soap and warm water for 20 seconds - about the time it takes to sing the "Happy Birthday" song twice.
 4. Summer often means more snacks and treats. Before the term starts get your children back on three regular meals including a good breakfast.
 5. Manage stress for children and parents that can lead to insomnia and sluggishness. Discuss with children anything that's bothering them and take care not to overload anyone's schedule, including your own.
