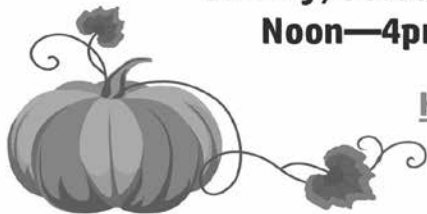

Emmaus Catholic Parish is partnering with Volunteer Legal Services of Austin to present at **FREE LEGAL CLINIC** for persons seeking legal assistance on the last Tuesday of each month, 6-9 PM in the PLC classrooms. The next session is Tuesday, Sept. 27, from 6:00-9:00 PM in Rm 203 & 204. Sign-in occurs between 6-7:00 PM. Spanish language interpreters are available. No childcare available.

Literacy Partners is a faith based group of volunteers who want to see our students excel. We spend 30 mins to 1 hr per week at an assigned day and time reading to and having an assigned student read to us. This program has proven to help the students who are struggling with reading for whatever reason. It has also been proven that students who don't read to level by the third grade struggle the remainder of their school years. I have been a part of this program and have seen the improvement in the students I was blessed to read to. They are amazing and look forward to their time with their assigned volunteer. This program is only during the school year and usually runs from the end of October until the beginning of May. Dear Parents of Children Grades 2-6,

Consider having your children join the Junior (Children's) Choir this year! It is super-convenient, inclusive and easier than ever before. The group sings at the 10:30 AM Mass the 2nd and 4th (and opt. 5th) Sundays of the month; and we practice every other week when we sing on Sunday. Practices on Wednesday 4:30 OR Friday at 4:30.

This is a serious choir. They are a children's choir, but NOT a "childish" choir. The focus is on music and leading the assembly. Our goal is to have the children able to sing at their Mass without the help of adults!
