Helping Hand of Spicewood Crisis Ministry

One hundred forty-two clients came to the Helping hand of Spicewood Crisis Ministry requesting food assistance for their 410 family members. Five of these clients were first-time visitors.

Forty-nine families received financial assistance totaling \$7,266. Housing assistance totaled \$4,818, transportation and communication assistance totaled \$1,706, and dental / medical assistance totaled \$742. The cost for food and personal hygiene products was \$1,355. Because of extensive Vista House renovation work, ministry operating expenses were abnormally high at \$3,663. Expenditures totaled \$14,784, which included \$2,500 for holiday gift cards. Donations totaled \$27,217.

At month's end, the Vista House was occupied by a single mom with 3 kids who would otherwise be homeless. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.


