# Helping Hand of Spicewood Crisis Ministry

### EMMAUS THANKS YOU!

One hundred sixteen clients came to the ministry requesting food assistance for their 246 family members. Three of these clients were first-time visitors. Forty-nine families received financial assistance totaling \$5,852. Housing assistance totaled \$3,112, transportation and communication assistance totaled \$1,913, and dental / medical assistance totaled \$827. The cost for food and personal hygiene products was \$2,611. Ministry operating expenses were \$573. Expenditures totaled \$9,036 and donations totaled \$3,870. At month's end, the Vista House was occupied by a single mom with 3 kids who would otherwise be homeless. May God continue to bless this ministry and all who make it possible.

**Parish Nursing Ministry:**

What Happens When My Teen Does Not Get Enough Sleep?

Parents know that sleep is important for children – but chances are, they might not know just how vital getting a healthy night’s sleep can be for TEENS. Scientists have established that just like a healthy diet and exercise, sleep is critical for children to stay healthy, grow, learn, do well in school, and function at their best.



The primary consequences of poor sleep among children and adolescents are behavior problems, impaired learning and school performance, mood and emotion problems, and worse health including obesity. Concerning new evidence also indicates that adolescents’ sleep may be related to high-risk behaviors such as substance use, suicidal behaviors, and drowsy driving . A recent study found that greater media use in teens was linked to a higher body mass index, largely because of reduced sleep time.

However, it is not just a matter of getting sufficient sleep quantity – children and adolescents, like adults, also need adequate sleep quality . Young children can be deceptively hyperactive with insufficient sleep or because of a sleep disorder. Of course, any child or adolescent (or their parent) who snores, falls asleep at inappropriate times, or has other sleep disorders symptoms should talk to their doctor as soon as possible. A major developmental change during adolescence is that their body’s clock moves to a later timing for sleep. However, this is only thought to be about one hour of a change, and another two hours of change is due to social factors, such as work pressures and access to technology. As with parents, balancing these time pressures is hard work. All screens should be off one hour before time set for bed.

To help meet these challenges, families can work together to make sleep a priority, so that everyone has the opportunity to sleep as much as they need in a safe, quiet, comfortable environment. Perhaps not surprisingly, a recent study showed that reducing screen time, increasing sleep, and eating dinner together helped kids maintain a healthy weight.
