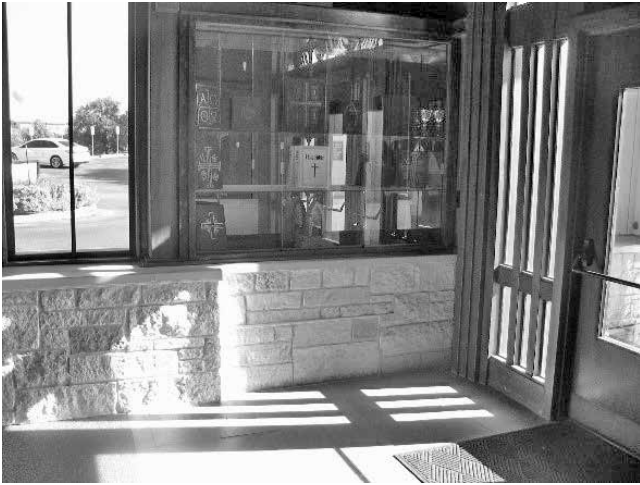

Perpetual Adoration at Emmaus Parish is struggling and we need your commitment. We will be having signup volunteers in the church after all the Masses the first three weekends in June to bolster the faithful adorers some of whom have been coming multiple times during the week to make sure that there is always someone in the chapel when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.

Over the next several weeks we will be writing about Perpetual Adoration, what it means to the Church and what it has meant to Emmaus Parish.

Saint Teresa of Calcutta wrote in a letter: “Perpetual Adoration with exposition needs a great push. People ask me: ‘What will convert America and save the world?’ My answer is prayer. What we need is for every Parish to come before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament in Holy Hours of Prayer.”

Did you know that there is a Prayer Capsule built into the wall of the church at Emmaus? Our parish is founded on prayer. In 1996, over 600 families took the leap of

faith to build a church and incur a \$14 million dollar debt. In 1999 construction began on our first building and those families were asked to commit to praying for the parish and putting their commitment into a vault which was enclosed in the wall near the West Narthex entrance.

Please prayerfully reflect if you can commit one hour a week to coming to visit with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. You do not have to wait until June. You can contact us any time at liturgy@emmausparish.org or just call the parish office.
