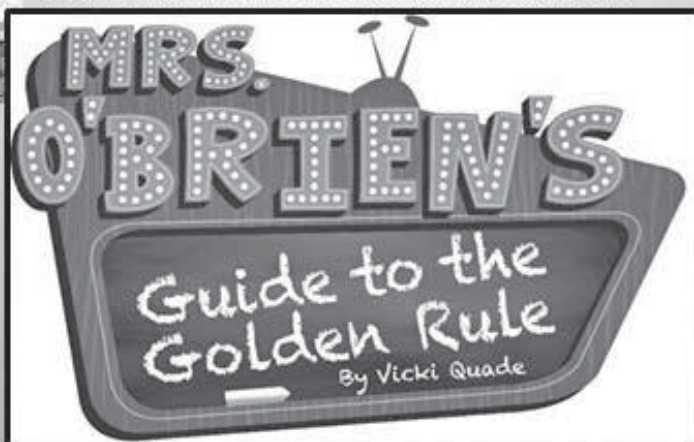

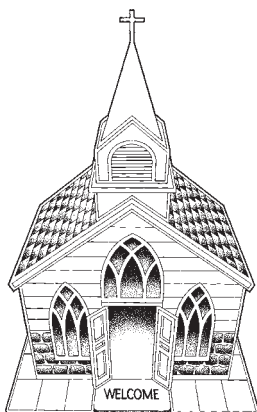

Did you know: Did you know that we dedicated the Saint John of the Cross Chapel on May 27, 2011. We had 2300 families, and we had only one hour that needed to be filled, Friday from 5PM to 6PM. We were able to continue full, 24 hour Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until March of 2016. We are now engaged in a recruiting drive to return to 24 hour exposition.
