RULES

Today's Date: _____

Please initial:

Fall Fest is Sunday, October 1. Set-up can begin at 10 AM. Vehicles used to deliver must be removed from craft booth area by 11:30 AM. Clean-up must be completed by 5 PM.

Fall Fest runs from Noon to 4 PM. Crafter must be present the entire time.

All items are handmade by the crafter – please check these:

- No reselling of old or used items.
- No selling of items made from a kit.
- No food items unless it is packaged for consumption at a later time, i.e., jam.
- No company products, i.e., Avon or Pampered Chef.
- No order taking, items must be present and taken home that day by the buyer.
- No items that require personalization that cannot be done at Fall Fest.

Rectangle, 6ft table & 2 chairs are provided. Electricity NOT be provided. Two crafters may share a table. Nothing can be drilled, stapled, or glued to the table. Taped is okay. Recommended: bring a table cloth. Shade not provided. Crafter may provide their own tent.

The Fall Fest Committee assigns spaces. No changes allowed. No signage provided. Max space available is 6x6 feet. Crafter is responsible for returning the space and table to original condition.

Photographs taken of booth and crafter are permissible. Emmaus may use these photos in future publications including print and social media.

Using the description of craft provided by crafter, Emmaus' Fall Fest Committee determines which crafters may have a table at the Fall Fest. Preference is given to 1) Emmaus registered parishioners, 2) Order in which completed application is received and 3) Consideration given to a good variety of merchandise, type and appeal to buyers.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT: I have read the rules and agree to abide by them.
